Adult/Youth Tournament



The Bill Close Adult/Youth Tournament will be held December 14, 20 and 21 at Southwyck Lanes. Entry fee for youth and adult bowlers each is \$15.00. There are

six divisions based on team average and the youth bowlers gender. Div A.- 381 and up; Div. B. 321-380 and Div. C. 320 and under. Adults may bowl with up

to three youth bowlers per squad. The charity chosen for this years' donation is Toledo Gospel Rescue Mission.

2015 Youth Team Championship

The Team Event of the GTUSBCA Youth City Championships will be held at Interstate Lanes, 819 Lime City Road, Rossford on January 18, 24 and 25. There will be six divisions, with averages categories of: 641 and over; 401-640; and 400 and under in both make and female events.

Entry fee is \$18.00 with a prepaid entry fee of \$16.00 per entrant.

Averages are based on 2013-14 final averages or current averages based on 12 games if no previous year average.

NOTE: Each bowler who participates in the GTUSBCA Youth Team, Doubles and

Singles Tournaments will be competing for a \$200 scholarship. The highest nine game total in actual and handicap in each division will be awarded the scholarship. The first score bowled in each event will be used for All Events.



Masters Tournament

The 46th Annual Masters Tournament will be held on Sunday, November 23rd at 10:00 AM at Southwyck Lanes. Entry Fee is \$80.00 and First

Place will pay \$800.00 based on 50 entries.

Qualifying consists of eight games across 16 lanes with the top eight bowlers go-

ing on to single elimination (2 out of 3 game) match play. Come out and watch Toledo's best bowlers compete for the much coveted title.
