The Ohio State USBC Bowling Association Championship Tournament will be held right here in Toledo, with the team event being held at Interstate Lanes in Rossford and the doubles and singles held at Southwyck Lanes.

The tournament which is sponsored by Ebonite will run consecutive weekends beginning with February 25th through May 13th, with the exception of Waster weekend. Every weekend of the tournament two bowling balls, provided by Ebonite will be given away to two participants in the doubles and singles event.

The number of participants in last years' Championship event was 1253 -5 person teams. Bowlers traveling to the Toledo area can expect to share in the estimated total prize list of approximately \$160,00.00

Entries are available at all bowling centers in Toledo and entry into the tournament will close December 29, 2011.

This tournament will not only bring approximately 6,500 bowlers plus their wives, husbands and families to the local area, but a conservative estimate of \$4-\$6 million will be added into the local community revenues.
