Entry fee is \$16.00 per person and the final closing is January 29 @ 12:30 PM.

All Events Scholarship Eligibility: Each bowler who participates in the GTUS-BCA Youth Team, Doubles and Singles will be competing for a \$100.00 scholarship. The highest 9 game total in actual and handicap in each division will be awarded the scholarship. The first time bowled in each event will be used for All Events.

New age division will be used for the Youth Tournaments this year as follows:

"A" 171 and over

"B" 131-170

"C" 101-130

"D" 100 and under

With both boy/girl classes.

Bowlers will use their highest average from 2010/2011 as an entering average. If they have no average from 2010-2011 they will use their current average as of 12 games or more, at the time of the squad.

The Youth Doubles event will be held at Interstate Lanes on Feb. 18, 19, and 20.

The Singles event will be

held at Miracle Lanes on March 11, 18 and 19. The singles event will also feature a separate Scholarship opportunity for the youth bowlers.
