Wes Horner turned in the highest actual series of the tournament with games of 300-213-299 for an 812 total. Running a close second in actual series was Scott Christy who scored an 802 in the singles event.

KIDS for KIDS Champions Named

The Toledo Area Youth Bowlers are learning about community awareness at an early age while being able to participate in their favorite sports activity. From November 21st through November 29th, at Twin Oaks Lanes 64 youth participants took part in the Kids for Kids Charity Bowling Tournament. This charity benefit is one of the unsung events supported by the bowling community. Part of the entry fee includes a new toy and over 70 toys were donated to a local children's service organization for distribution during the Christmas holidays.

In the Division A category, which is a 190 and over average, Chad Rieger was named champion with a 707 actual score and 710 handicap.

In Division B category, which is a 160 – 189 average, Eddie Cline Jr. claimed first place with an actual 600 series in addition to his 174 handicap for a 774 score.

In Division C category, which is 120— 159 average, Cooper Isbell rose to the top shooting a 521 actual score with 258 pins handicap for a total of 779.
